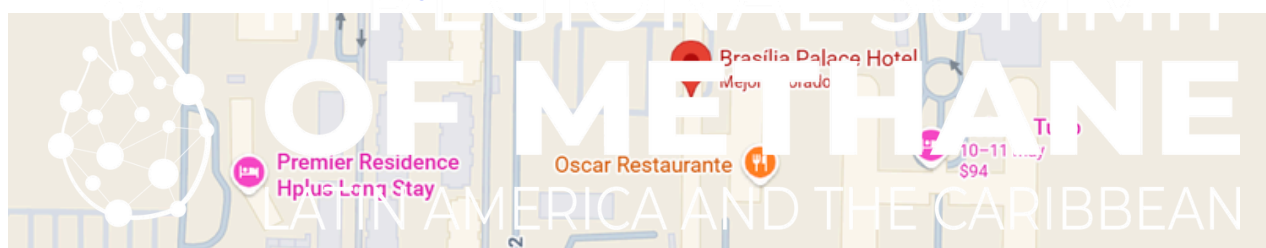

1. VENUE

4. TRAVEL – VISA

Accredited delegations from OLACDE Member Countries will receive their travel details in advance.

MERCOSUR member countries may travel using their respective identity documents, while participants from other countries must have a valid passport (with at least six months validity after the departure date) and complete visa procedures if required.

5. TRANSPORTATION

Presidente Juscelino Kubitschek International Airport is the main airport in Brasília and one of the most important in the country. It is located approximately 11 km from the city center, with easy access to the hotel area and the Esplanade of Ministries.

Taxis: Available in the arrival area or through mobile apps. The approximate cost to the city center ranges between USD 10 and USD 20, with travel time between 15 and 25 minutes.

Private transportation: Private transportation services and digital platforms operate at the airport. Advance coordination is recommended.

Tourism companies: Offer personalized transfers from the airport to the Hotel Sector and the Esplanade of Ministries.

Airport – hotel – airport: Accredited delegations from OLACDE Member Countries will have official transportation between the airport and the hotel.

6. ACCOMMODATION

For participants' accommodation, the following options are suggested:

7. VACCINES

No mandatory vaccines are required for entry into Brazil. However, vaccination against yellow fever is recommended depending on the travel itinerary.



9. CURRENCY

The Brazilian Real (BRL) is the official currency of the Federative Republic of Brazil. Banknotes in circulation are R\$2, R\$5, R\$10, R\$20, R\$50, and R\$100.

Credit and debit cards are widely accepted in shops, restaurants, and hotels. Currency exchange offices and ATMs are available at the airport and throughout the city.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

Time: Brasília local time is UTC-3 throughout the year (there is no daylight saving time).

Electricity: The standard voltage in Brasília is 220V with a frequency of 60Hz. Plugs are type N (often compatible with type C). Bringing a universal adapter is recommended to avoid inconvenience.



Language: Portuguese is the official language of Brazil.

Communication: Brazil's international dialing code is +55.

11. WEATHER

Brasília has a tropical savanna climate characterized by a dry season and a rainy season. June corresponds to the dry season, with pleasant temperatures and low humidity.

The average temperature during this period ranges between 14°C and 26°C, with sunny days, cool nights, and a low probability of rain. Light clothing is recommended during the day, along with a jacket for the evenings.

Estimated weather forecast based on historical data for the event dates: maximum temperatures between 24°C and 27°C, and minimum temperatures between 13°C and 16°C.
